Baby Bottle Shower Favors

What You'll Need:

- Plastic Baby Bottles with Tops
- Assorted Plastic Shower Favors/Decorations
- Ribbon
- Candy or Mints
- Label Sheets (Peel & Stick Printable Paper)
- Scissors

Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- 1. Design and print labels with the mommy's name and shower date, or a different mesage (see example of our label to the left). We printed our labels 12 to a page on 8½x11" label sheets, then cut them out.
- 2. Cut a piece of ribbon about 12" long.
- 3. Remove lid from the bottle, place your ribbon around the neck of the bottle, and tie a knot in the ribbon.
- 4. Take your shower favor/decoration and thread the ribbon through.
- 5. Tie a bow to secure the ribbon and the favor to the baby bottle.
- 6. Adhere your custom-made label to the front of the bottle.
- 7. Fill each bottle with nuts, mints, or other candies and get ready for the guests to arrive!
