On-the-Go Diaper Clutch

What You'll Need:

- Fabric Placemat
- Ribbon
- Needle and Thread
- Scissors
- Embellishments (optional)



Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

1. Cut a piece of ribbon that is about twice as long as your placemat.
2. Place your placemat design side down on a flat surface and fold the long sides of the placemat in about 1½" on both sides.
3. Fold the short sides of the placemat in about 2½" to 3" on both sides.
4. Fold the entire placemat in half so the short sides touch. Pull one of the short sides over the top of the other to create the top of the clutch. Fold the corners in to create a more finished look.
5. Determine the back of the placemat and, using the needle and thread, sew the ribbon onto the placemat.
6. Tie the ribbon around the clutch and you're done, unless you want to add a few embellishments.
7. Fill the clutch with a few diapers and some wipes and stow it in your purse or car and you're ready for any diaper changing emergency! Plus, the clutch becomes the changing pad so you won't have to lay your baby down on any less-than-sanitary public changing tables.
