Easy Step-by-Step Directions:

- 1. Add two quarts of hot tap water to the stock pot and place it over a burner on low heat.
- 2. Stir in ¼-cup salt, then add 8 ounces of liquid dye or two 1½-oz. packages of powder dye to the water. Heat the mixture over low heat for five minutes.
- 3. Add rose petals to the dye solution and stir them well to be sure that they are all completely immersed in the dye.
- 4. Allow the petals to simmer on low heat for three to six hours, depending on how dark you want your petal color.
- 5. Once the petals have reached the desired hue, pour the dye and rose petals into a colander you place in your sink to drain out the dye. Thoroughly rinse the petals under cool running water until the water runs clear.
- 6. Spread the petals on a towel to dry. Once dry, you should store petals in a dark place to prevent fading until you are ready to use them.
